Dear all.

The Pico's have been moved into Row D. The reason for this is the safety of the kids using their picos as I am wary of them pulling them across the road and they are in a concentrated view for the parents on the balcony.

On this note, I am unable to move a Pico from the main red chip dinghy park to the new area due to it being chanded down. Could the owner please unlock it and move it and please let me know via the usual channels.
