1 RULES

- 1.1 The Organising Authority will be Largs Sailing Club supported by The Scottish Sailing Institute.
- 1.2 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 (RRS), the RYA prescriptions to these Rules, the RS800 Class Rules and the organiser's sailing instructions. In the event of any conflict, the sailing instructions shall prevail.

2 ADVERTISING

The event is designated Category C.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to the RS800 Class, with either Helm or Crew having membership of the RS Class Association.
- 3.2 Eligible teams may enter by completing the appropriate entry form and sending it, together with the required fee to the following address:

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration upon receipt of a completed entry form and the appropriate fee.

- 7.1 The venue will be Largs Sailing Club
- 7.2 The Race Areas will be the Largs Channel or the waters to the North of the Island of Great Cumbrae.

8 THE COURSES

The courses will be described in detail in the Sailing Instructions.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 9.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.3 (a) When fewer than 5 races are completed, a boats series score shall be the total of her race scores.
(b) When from 4 to 7 races have been completed, a boats series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
(c) When 8 or more races have been completed, a boats series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be as determined by the Organising Authority.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 000 000 per event or the equivalent.
