The Organising Authority is Largs Sailing Club

NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats where the person in charge is a full member of Largs Sailing Club.

- 2.2 Eligible dinghies may enter each race by completing the entry form available from the OOD prior to the start of each days racing.

Dinghies shall be divided into classes dependent on their Portsmouth Yardstick as follows:

(a) Slow Handicap for dinghies with a handicap greater or equal to 1082

(b) Fast Handicap for dinghies with a Handicap less than 1082

- 2.3 Eligible Keelboats may enter using an entry form available from the OOD . Presence at the start line at start time will be taken as intention to race. All keelboats shall start together.

(a) Keelboats using spinnakers will display pennant 1 on their backstay

(b) Keelboats sailing with restricted sail will display pennant 2 on their backstay. Spinnakers shall not be flown. Only one headsail may be flown at any one time except for cutter rigged (or similar) yachts that have 2 or more headsails recorded on their CYCA rating certificate and allows them to fly the recorded number of headsails simultaneously. They will have 1.5 added to their handicaps.

Keelboats must sail in either restricted sail or spinnaker configuration for the entirety of a series.

3 SCHEDULE

- 3.1 Registration must be completed at any time prior to the first warning signal for the first race that the competitor enters.

- 3.2 The racing is scheduled to take place on Wednesdays and Sundays split into a number of series, with the season running between the dates listed below;

(a) between 17 April 2011 and 20 November 2011 for Sunday Races

(b) between 20 April 2011 and 14 September 2011 for Wednesday Races

Full details of the specific series dates are in the Sailing Instructions.

3.5 The scheduled times of the warning signals for the first race each day are:

- (a) For races taking place on Sundays: 14:00
- (b) For races taking place on Wednesdays: 19:10

4 MEASUREMENTS

- (a) Each dinghy shall comply with their class rules in regard to measurement.
- (b) Each keelboat shall produce a valid CYCA Rating Certificate. In exceptional circumstances boats that cannot produce a CYCA Rating Certificate shall be allocated a rating by the race committee.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available on the Largs Sailing Club website.

6 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
